

Do you ever wonder if you're providing your daughter with everything she needs to be successful? That concern runs through my head sometimes. Thoughts like, "What wisdom have I imparted?" and "Is it enough?" Can you relate?!

There was a recent article that listed 10 keys to success. It included things like making a plan and taking small risks. But the one I liked most was number four—develop good habits. If you ask me, that should've been number one! Not because making plans and taking risks aren't important, but because there is one specific habit we need to teach our daughters to be successful.

SUBJECT:

Wisdom that sticks

SETTING:

Your home (preferably your daughter's room)

MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

Owl Pen

Sticky Prayers Booklet

Your Bibles







This month's mom+daughter connection experience is an invitation to begin learning how to share the gospel. As always, we've done most of the planning for you to have a formative connecting conversation with your girl.

Read Joshua 1:8 with your daughter and discuss these questions:

- What is the key to living successfully, according to this Bible verse?
- What are some ways you meditate on God's Word?
- Are you meditating on God's Word regularly? Or do you need to set some new goals about how you do that in 2022?

Watch Staci's coaching video. This will help you start the conversation with your daughter about one area where we can experience good success: healthy emotions. You'll learn about letting the truth of God's Word "stick."

Replacing lies with God's Truth. Meditating on God's Word daily helps us combat the untruths we may think about ourselves with the Truth God says about us. Talk about some feelings your daughter may be having that don't line up with what God says about her. Maybe ask her these questions to start the conversation:

- Have you been having any negative emotions lately? About what?
- What are some other scriptures that tell us the truth about those emotions?
- How can you apply those scriptures in your daily life?

write some "slicky fruit" notes for yourself. Grab some post-it notes and a funky pen. Go through some of the scriptures you just talked about. (If you are using a physical Bible, put a sticky tab next to those verses.) Now, write some prayers on the sticky pad that line up with the Truth of those verses. Have your daughter stick them around her

room, and maybe even the bathroom (if she's comfortable with her siblings getting toothpaste on them!). Mom, you can write a couple "sticky prayers" of your own and post them where you can always see them. It's
