# H. Mom!

This month, we're helping you plant a desire to worship—not just the habit of singing—into her life. Does your daughter know that worship is not the same as singing?

We often get caught in the snare of thinking that it's those isolated moments during a church service when our hands and voices are lifted to the Lord. While some times of worship should be set apart to include music, the truth is that worship is a lifestyle. Our conversations, daily behavior, social media posts, spending habits and everything else we do either makes God's good work in us known. Or not.

And teaching this to our girls begins with us! Whether we're cleaning our homes to host guests or helping our children with their homework, everything we do is an opportunity to make His glory known to the world through our Spirit filled living.

Sing to the Lord, for He has done wonderful things.

Make known His praise around the world.

## Preparing for Your March Mom + Daughter Date

## LIVING A LIFE OF WORSHIP



#### SUBJECT:

Lives That Sing God's Praises

#### **SETTING:**

Your home

### MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

Tambourine or other musical (rhythmic) instrument

Notepad

Your Bibles

This month's mom+daughter connection experience is all about your daughter learning to live worshipfully every day of the week. As promised, we've done most of the planning and thinking for you to have a formative connecting conversation with your girl.

Create a fun, peaceful space in your home. The kind that's just right for diving into God's Word, meditating on His goodness, and singing praises to His name.



## Read Isaiah 12:5 with your daughter.

And discuss these questions.

- Why is God worthy of our worship?
- Who has the opportunity to hear about God when we worship?
- How do we worship? What does it look like?





## Watch Staci's coaching video.

This will help you start the conversation with your daughter about worship and how it extends to every aspect of our lives. You'll learn about how everything we do through God's Spirit is worshipful to Him.



## Learn how to live worshipfully.

Worship helps us live grounded, thankful, and courageous lives in Christ. When we tune our hearts to notice the wonderful ways in which God is moving every day, we experience true joy and are propelled to further trust the Lord and move confidently in the direction He calls.

Help your daughter pinpoint areas in her life where God is doing wonderful things that should propel her to worship Him and make His praise known. Maybe ask her these questions to start the conversation:

- What's one thing you've seen God do lately in your life or someone else's?
- Are there any things God's done recently or in the past that you didn't really take notice of and worship Him for?
- How can we share the goodness of God and the amazing things He's done with the world?



## Write a worship song together.

Grab your favorite notebook, your tambourine, your Bible, and a glass of water for those pipes. Don't be afraid of this task! It doesn't have to be perfect or sound any kind of way. Whatever you create for the Lord is beautiful and worshipful to Him.

Start off by praying and asking the Lord to guide your heart as you create. Then, put the pen to the paper! If you need an idea of how to write a song based on what God has done in your life, read Exodus 15 where Moses and Miriam worshipped God for helping them cross the Red Sea!

When writing, make sure you include lyrics that worship God, both in spirit and Truth. "In spirit" lyrics describe what the Lord is doing in your heart personally. These are lines linked to your unique experience and creativity. They aren't taken directly from scripture but are backed by the connective presence of the Holy Spirit within you and flavored by God's gift of creativity given to you. Lines like "My heart is filled by your love like the sun overwhelms the sky."

"In Truth" lyrics sing the Lord's words back to Him. Adding a verse like Psalm 63:4 "I will praise you as long as I live, lifting up my hands to you in prayer" would be an example of pulling from the Truth of God's Word for your song. Next, you'll use your tambourine to create a rhythm. Create the melody with your voice. If you own any other musical instruments, feel free to use them as well!

P.S. If the idea of writing a song scares you, just call it a worship poem and recite it. No pressure, just worshipful fun!
